What is Explicit Content Creation?

When content manipulation technology or artificial intelligence (AI) is used to exploit photos and videos - typically captured from social media, the internet, or requested from the individual - into sexually themed images and videos that appear real and are posted on the internet, social media, or to pornographic websites.

What is Sextortion?

A crime that involves coercing individuals into providing sexually explicit photos or videos of themselves, then threatening to share them publicly to illicit content, money, or compliance from the individual. To find out more about sextortion, visit these websites





Use of fear tactics


